Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the Day of Judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world (1 John 4:17).

Hebrews 1:3 tells us that Jesus Christ is the express image of the Father. Meaning that, He's the perfect imprint, and image of the Father. When He walked the earth, He was the revelation of the Father's will, and the expression of His righteousness and goodness. He gave expression to the nature and character of the Father, and this is our calling today; we're to give expression to His will and nature.

You're called and sent by God to manifest and administer His will, purpose, and character to your world, through the gift of righteousness. You've become, not only the recipient but also, the

dispenser of His goodness: “But ye are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a dedicated nation, God’s own purchased special people; that ye may set forth the wonderful deeds and display the virtues and perfections of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light” (1Peter 2:9 Amp).
